
Over ten years I was funded every year by grants from National lottery, Arts Council, Children in need etc

As a PO I earned £30k and lived in a 1 bed flat.


Year 1 of my CIC & LTD I earned £40k and bought a 3 bed house

Ten years of starting a CIC & LTD I bought a detached house by the sea, retired my husband, investing in property and could retire by 45 if I choose or just run a small enjoyable CIC art project 1 day a week.






4 strategies



- Pivot your CIC idea into multiple project to apply for over £100k+ of grants
- Budget to pay yourself 70% of a grant to ensure your sustainability
- Create proof of community
 engagement to avoid the number 1
 rejection reasons
- Reapply if rejected as your far more like to succeed!



1. How to pivot?

- Keep you name and mission wide
- Understand your CIC isn't just one idea
- Don't apply for many grants for just one idea. Create a series of small ideas that fit together
- Lean project ideas into different grant niches like sports, arts, heritage etc
- Work with several different community groups

2. Paying yourself



- Aim for 50%-75% in year one
- £150 day rate on most lottery grants
- Put days of work not hours or delivery
- £350-600 for arts and heritage

3. Community engagement

Key part of my strategy


- Surveys
- Taster sessions
- Feedback forms
- Feedback interviews audio recorded and make into a short video
- Always write impact reports after each project
- Always capture photo, video and quotes as you go and post on social leaving a trail of evidence



4. Learn to grow from rejection

- Rejection is part of the process
- Do not give up
- Read feedback and resubmit
- Adapt and review
- Think about easy projects you can get funded
- Reword applications to take out anything that puts them off but be clever and still do what you want

Grant & Pay Calculator





Step 1 choose your grants year 1

Lottery Community fund £20k **Sports England £15k Active Partnership £10k** Local Council funding £10k Arts council main grant £30k Heritage Lottery £30k Alan Lane £5k UNLTD £8k Another national grant £10k add up the total






Step 1 choose your grants year 2

Lottery Reaching Communities up to £500k **Sports England £15k** Children in need £15k Local Council funding £20k Arts council main grant £60k Heritage Lottery £100k Paul Hameln Foundation £150k Esme Fairbank £50k UNLTD £18k Another national grant £10k add up the total





Grants under £20k pay your self up to £75%

Grants over 20K-£100k pay no more than £50k max

Grant over £100k you will need to hire more than three staff and can pay yourself a salary of £50-80k max for all CIC work

Tip... you can get more money to yourself my applying for multiple small grants as a freelancer self employed person rather that going to large grants with an employee salary.



Year one aim for £100k grants Pay yourself £75k but you will do alot of the work

Year two you could go for a large grant that will cover three years and pay yourself a salary of £80k and hire more people to help with the work
